

SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGO CONTRACT #15102

WHEREAS, the Ohio Attorney General (“Attorney General”) and Promega Corporation (“Promega”) previously entered into an Agreement (AGO Contract No. 15102) between the Ohio Attorney General and Promega and a First Amendment to AGO Contract No. 15102 effective September 22, 2022 (collectively the “Agreement”);

WHEREAS, the Attorney General and Promega now desire to amend the Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, the Attorney General and Promega agree to enter into this Second Amendment to the Agreement as follows:

1. Add the following Paragraph C: “The price, products, quantity and other relevant sales information for the period starting on July 1, 2023 and ending on June 30, 2024 (“FY24”) are set forth in Promega’s quotes attached hereto as Exhibit s4 and 5. Attorney General is purchasing services and products for FY24 in the amount of \$35,949.56 as set forth in Exhibit 4, and may purchase up to \$535,436.00 worth of products during FY24 at the prices set forth in Exhibit 5. The total price paid by the Attorney General to Promega during FY24 may not exceed \$571,385.56.
2. Add Exhibits 4 and 5 attached hereto.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain the same.
