Project Identification:

Community Crossroads, Inc., proposes a **new construction** project to be situation on a two-acre lot directly to the north of our newly purchased women's residential treatment program. The lot is on the edge of Wooster and is scenic and peaceful. The newly constructed 3,200 sq. ft., one story "house" will have six bedrooms with two residents residing in each of the bedrooms, three bathrooms (one being handicapped accessible). There will also be a living room, a great room with a living room, kitchen, and an office. There will be an asphalt driveway and there is access to public transportation.

Program Summary:

Community Crossroads, Inc./OneEighty's staff will ideally be peer supporters who can assist residents newly in recovery. Residents will attend treatment on an outpatient basis at the treatment facility of their choice. These services and support may include outpatient counseling, intensive outpatient program, medication assisted treatment (MAT), case management, recovery coaching, outpatient addiction treatment, family treatment, an opportunity to participate in a recovery club, rental assistance, financial management courses, and mental health services. **Community Crossroads, Inc. (solely owned by OneEighty, Inc.)**, works closely with the **Mental Health and Recovery Services Board of Wayne & Holmes Counties**.
