PROJECT BACKGROUND:	Pandemic conditions have disrupted learning as well as classroom and school activities, but they have also increased educator capabilities and comfort with virtual professional learning. The Office of Approaches to Teaching and Professional Learning's Literacy Team will leverage this new capacity to address learning loss through free, accessible virtual professional learning to support educators in addressing student literacy needs using evidence-based practices.		
PROJECT JUSTIFICATION:	Development of virtual professional learning allows the state to use pandemic relief resources to support educators with professional learning and training to address student learning loss and individual learning needs. The production of virtual professional learning ensures sustainability of the investment as learning products will remain available and freely accessibl on the department's website on an ongoing basis. The production of on-demand trainings will allow participation by educators and stakeholders who may otherwise be unable to attend based on pandemic conditions or staffing availability.		
PROJECT OBJECTIVE:	This project will support the state's literacy team in developing professional learning that includes examples from Ohio classrooms and national experts. The Offeror will coordinate preproduction and perform recording and postproduction of video footage of educators engaging in evidence-based language and literacy practices that accelerate reading achievement. These videos will be used in various Department professional learning venues (Learning Management System, literacy academy on demand, live trainings).

## SCOPE OF WORK:

The selected offeror shall collaborate with the Department to identify educators engaging in specific practices described in Ohio's Plan to Raise Literacy Achievement and Ohio's Literacy Academy on Demand. The Offeror shall communicate with Department contracted experts to schedule recording, obtain appropriate rights and releases from participants to publicly post recordings, record presentations, interviews, or classroom activities, and edit video footage. This footage will be used by the Department in Literacy Academy on Demand, Reaching All Students Through Literacy, and other coursework.

The Offeror shall coordinate with Ohio's Literacy Team to identify professional learning needs and plan projects. The offeror shall work with recording participants, including Department contracted local and national experts to coordinate preproduction aspects of recording, including clear communication of project goals and expectations, requirements for quality filming, and securing any necessary releases and permission.

The offeror shall provide adequate staff and technical capacity to record (remote and onsite) educators engaging in evidence-based language and literacy practices and professional learning presentations, including providing guidance and support for experts during recording to ensure a quality product.

The offeror shall provide adequate staff, technical capacity, and rights\* to edit, produce and store recording to ensure a quality product. The Department shall maintain ownership of all materials developed as a result of this contract. The Offeror shall work with the Department in obtaining necessary rights and permissions to any music, imagery, or student participation that may be included in developed materials. \*Rights should include music, images, or other components the offeror deems necessary for a quality product.

Professional learning shall include recording of presentations by experts, classroom activities, and interviews with education professionals. 5–10-minute segments for the Learning Management System or Literacy Academy On-Demand, hour long segments for the Literacy Academy Live, or half or full day live professional learning support as needed by the department. It is estimated that about 60-70 short segments, 16 hour long segments and six day long sessions will require production needs over the contract period. Recording and production needs for the 2022-23 school year will be determined by October 2022 and by October 2023 for the 2023-2024 school year. The Department requests the Offeror have adequate capacity to support up to 80 hours per month of recording production.
