The 3.5 Level of Care residential treatment facility will provide clinical care to men with mental health and or substance use disorders. The newly constructed facility will house 9 units for men aged 18 and older. The 7,970 square foot facility will serve up to 16 men at any given time. Being constructed are 7 double bed bedrooms, 2 single bed bedrooms, a living room, dining room, kitchen, pantry, a group therapy room, 5 bathrooms, 3 offices, a laundry room, and a reception space. There are many points of access to the program, including the local court system, probation services, Job and Family Services, local community service providers, family of the person in need, and/or the individual in need themselves. Residential Treatment Facilities are staffed 24 hours a day/seven days a week that provides room, board, personal care, and clinical services onsite as part of the treatment stay. Typically, a congregate setting is included with this living environment as defined in the license. Entrance and discharge are determined by clinical/ medical need. A congregate setting is defined as single site residence that provides group living, residents may share bedrooms, bathrooms and living areas. Residential treatment facilities can be for mental health or substance use treatment.

Program Summary:

ADAMHS Board of Tuscarawas and Carroll Counties, provides Residential Treatment for Men in Tuscarawas County for mental health, behavioral health, and substance abuse disorder issues. The participants are given clinical services, weekly group counseling, case management, weekly family and individual counseling, and SUD services which helps to promote recovery and resiliency and stabilize the community. The Tuscarawas County ADAMHS Board partners with Ohio Guidestone, Job and Family Services, local law enforcement probation offices, and the Hopeline which is the single point of access for SUD information and referrals in Tuscarawas County.
